

Supply List for 6th & 7th Grades

- A 1 to 3 inch binder with 5-6 dividers--recommending pocket folders as dividers
- For assignments:
 - 2 or more packages of wide OR college-ruled loose leaf binder paper; wide is recommended for math assignments and for those whose handwriting is large
- For taking notes:
 - 2 or more packages of loose leaf binder paper
OR
 - 2-4 composition notebooks or spiral notebooks each for Math, World Studies, Life Science and Literacy; again, recommending wide-ruled for math.
- 1 composition book for English
- 1 package of graph paper with 4 or 5 squares to an inch
- 12-24 #2 wooden pencils or 2-3 mechanical pencils (with extra lead!)
- Eraser(s)--the white ones work best
- A hand held pencil sharpener with a section to hold the shavings
- 12-24 colored pencils
- 2-3 black or blue pens
- A pencil case
- A ruler
- A protractor and a compass
- 2-3 glue sticks
- A pair of scissors
- Bible: New International Version (NIV) with Old and New Testaments
- A backpack or school bag
- Pre-Alg Students: A Texas Instrument TI-30XIIS calculator
- Optional: earbuds for in-classroom chromebooks/iPads
