

WELLNESS POLICY

- Continuous Runny Nose or Green Nasal Drainage: Students with a continuous runny nose
 or green nasal drainage will be required to stay home until symptoms have cleared or until a
 healthcare provider provides a note allowing their return.
- Fever of 100.5°F or Higher in the Last 12 Hours: Students who have had a fever of 100.5°F or higher within the past 12 hours should not attend school until they are fever-free for at least 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication.
- **Diarrhea in the Last 24 Hours:** If a student has experienced diarrhea within the last 24 hours, they should remain at home until they have been symptom-free for at least 24 hours.
- **Vomiting in the Last 12 Hours:** Students who have vomited within the last 12 hours should not return to school until they have had no further vomiting for 24 hours.
- Undiagnosed Red and/or Drainage from Eyes, Sores, or Ears: Any unexplained or contagious discharge from the eyes, sores, or ears should be assessed by a healthcare provider. Students should not attend school until they have been cleared by a healthcare professional.
- Undiagnosed and/or Contagious Rash: If a student develops an undiagnosed or contagious rash, they should not come to school until the rash has been evaluated and determined and attested to be non-contagious by a healthcare provider.
- Excessive Cough: Students with a persistent and excessive cough should remain at home until they have been evaluated by a healthcare provider and are cleared to return to school.
- Severe Headache: Students experiencing severe headaches should seek medical evaluation.

 They should not attend school until the cause of the headache has been determined and they are cleared to return by a healthcare provider.

We kindly ask for your cooperation in following these guidelines to protect the health of all students and staff members. If your child exhibits any of these symptoms, please keep them home and seek guidance from a healthcare professional as necessary. In cases of contagious conditions, please notify the school so that we can take appropriate measures to prevent the spread of illness within our school community.
